Master of Art in Social Studies(Civil Society)

The Department of Civil Society Studies was established in 2021 by expanding the focus of the educational curriculum of the Department of NGO Studies which had been in successful operation since 2000. The principal aim of the Department of Civil Society Studies is to educate students about the issues related to civil society. 'Civil Society' is one of the most important concepts in the social sciences today and a key policy agenda among policymakers and practitioners. It refers to the collection of social organizations and groups that are distinct from, yet interact with, the government and the market. As many pointed out, apart from being a watchdog of government and business, a vibrant civil society is an important social partner for good governance for balanced and long-lasting socioeconomic development.

Civil societies in the contemporary world encounter many difficult issues, including developmental challenges, the system-level crisis of ideologies, digital technology revolutions, climate change, and questions related to democracy and human rights at local, national, and global levels. The study of civil society and its key players, civil society organizations, is not only at the forefront of multidisciplinary academic debates on complex and interconnected issues but the focus of professional interests and careers on many pressing agendas. In the Civil Society Studies program, students learn about the relationships between academic debates and the everyday practices and policies of civil society and civil society organizations(CSOs). The Civil Society Studies program supports developing strong local and global networks of people and organizations in civil society based on the combination of theories and practices.

To achieve these goals, the Civil Society Studies program provides students with a wide variety of subjects, organized around two themes. The one is our focus on the issues and agendas of the field. The other is our emphasis on the imperatives of the management capacity of people in civil society organizations. We seek to design our educational curriculum with a balance between these two themes. Under these two themes, we offer diverse courses that reflect the current challenges around the globe, ranging from the theoretical perspectives on different aspects of civil society, practical survey of the diverse socioeconomic problems, managerial skills for CSOs, to cooperation among civil society, government, and international organizations for better governance. After graduation, students will seek to develop careers in diverse CSO's at both local and global levels.
