Any modification or cancellation is not allowed. after completion of the application. Please verify the accuracy of personal information on the required form as the applicant will take full responsibility for errors of information and contact interruption.
Submission of Documents	 Original documents should be submitted. However, if they are unavailable, photocopies must be authenticated officially by the document-issuing institution or notarized by a public notary office. Documents written in foreign language other than Korean or English must be translated into Korean or English and notarized. Applicants must keep in mind that all of the submitted documents cannot be returned, and admissions will be rescinded if false information or unfair practice for admission is found to have been used at any time. The admissions staff reserves the right to require additional documents from applicants if they need to clarify the eligibility or verify the authenticity of the submitted materials, and if the documents required to verify the facts are insufficient, they will be disqualified. Applicants who submitted certificate of expected graduation(completion) must submit their graduation(completion) certificate to the Office of International Affairs by August 14(Thu.), 2025, and failure to submit the documents without a valid reason may invalidate a student's offer of admission.

- Most of the lectures in major courses are conducted in Korean(Except Global Studies), there are few lectures conducted in English. For more information, please contact the relevant department.
- Applicants should check the notice on the CNU Admissions Website(http://ipsi.cnu.ac.kr/html/uadm) for admissions procedures. The applicants will take full responsibility for any disadvantages arising from unconfirmed information.
 - * Information regarding admissions such as evaluation process, announcement of successful applicants etc. will not be notified individually.
- In most cases, the application fee is not refundable.
